

A LEVEL EXAMINATIONS

The number of entries (examinations taken) by students was 368 compared with 379 in 2013, 351 in 2012, 350 in 2011, 296 in 2010, 340 in 2009.

99.5% entries passed A2 at grades A*- E.

There were some excellent results from many departments with 34.69% of the entry gaining the highly prestigious A* or A grade. Excellent results were achieved in Biology, Chemistry, Drama, Law, English, History, French, Mathematics, Geography, Sociology, Textiles and Welsh.

There was a number of individual excellent performances with 17 students gaining 3 or more A grades or better at 'A' level.

AS EXAMINATIONS

The AS results represent progress in 'A' level courses half way through the 'A' level course. The results at AS are becoming a reasonable predictor of ultimate results the following year at 'A' level (A2) stage.

There were some outstanding individual performances by pupils. Five students gained 4 'A' grade passes, while a further 12 gained 3+ 'A' passes.

GCSE Results 2014 (Year 11)

The key facts in the GCSE examinations for pupils at the end of Year 11 in the Summer of 2014 are:-

- (i) 100% of students sitting GCSEs in Year 11 gained a qualification at A*- G.
- (ii) 77% of pupils passed five or more GCSEs at A*- C level.
- (iii) The number of pupils gaining eight or more GCSEs at A*/A in 2014 was 24 (30 in 2013).
- (iv) The number of grades designated U award (unclassified) in 2014 was 7.5 (7 in 2013, 4.5 in 2012, 6.5 in 2011 and 12.5 in 2010). This represents a dramatic reduction from 77 in 2003 and has been achieved by a consistent focus on controlled assessments/coursework being submitted and ensuring pupils attend for examinations at the correct date and on time.
