Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November: Visit to Chavenage House, near Tetbury in Gloucestershire The coach for this visit will leave the Atlantic Hotel at 9.30am and Sainsbury's Bridgend at 9.45am (approx). Chavenage is an Elizabethan manor house built mainly in 1576 on the site of an older building. It was enlarged in the 17<sup>th</sup> century and further altered in the eighteenth century. Notable features of the house are the great hall, the minstrels' gallery, the Renaissance style fireplace in the panelled dining room, the two tapestry rooms, the stained glass windows and the Oak Room which has elaborate 1590 panelling. Close to the house is the family chapel which has a tower, built as a folly in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. We'll visit Chavenage in the afternoon, having had lunch together on the way.
