GCSE and A Level Exams – KS4 & KS5

The summer examinations start this week, and on Thursday 9th May over 200 Year 11 students will sit their first GCSE examination paper – GCSE Numeracy Paper 1. We wish all Year 10, Year 11, Year 12, and Year 13 students the very best for their summer examinations.

I am sure that all Year 11, Year 12, and Year 13 families have received my previous letters which included details about study leave, so by means of a brief update:

- Year 11: Study Leave will be granted from the week commencing 3rd June 2024 and until this date, students will be expected to attend school as normal. All students will attend lessons and revise and prepare accordingly. Students will sit examinations as usual then return to lessons. For the next two and a half weeks a bespoke revision programme and a revised timetable will be put in place to support all students. We have the leavers assembly to look forward to soon. All students must remain in school until Friday 24thMay 2024.
- Year 12: Normal teaching finishes this week, Friday 10th May. Monday 13th May is the first AS examination paper and Monday 3rd June is the date of the last AS examination paper. Students will not be expected to attend normal lessons during this period unless their teacher requests it. On Monday 10th June, all students should attend school for the Year 13 Induction Programme in the Sixth Form Hall. All students must attend, there is a lot planned this year and the induction programme has been designed to support the move from AS to A2.
- Year 13: Lessons continue until Friday 17th May. Monday 20th May is the first A Level paper and Thursday 20th June is the date of the last A Level examination paper. I am sure all are looking forward to the Sixth Form Summer Ball on Friday 5th July and our Leavers' Ceremony on Friday 17th May.

As you will see from the dates above, it is a busy few weeks ahead. To all students, I wish you all the very best for your forthcoming examinations – Good Luck!
