Warmer Weather 26th June & 27th June

To ensure that students are as comfortable as possible, for Wednesday 26th June and Thursday 27th June I will temporarily allow students to wear their school PE kit instead of their school uniform. The temperatures look set to peak tomorrow and return to a cooler temperature towards the end of the week.
